Caregiver training course are designed to prepare students for career as caregiver. Sometimes called as personal health aide, Caregiver perform delegated nursing task under the supervision of a licensed nurse. The course outline focuses on theories and supervised practical training in a simulation laboratory that will provide hands-on learning experience for the students. Our simulation laboratory is equipped to mimic the bedside clinical set up to fully immerse student in clinical experience.

Bedside teaching is a vital component of medical education and one of the most effective ways to learn clinical and communication skills. The course will prepare the students with the roles and responsibilities as a Caregiver. The course outline will cover caregiver standards, role and limitations, job description, delegation process, maintaining competence and continuing education.

What does Caregiver do?

- Assist patient in their Activities of Daily Living (ADL's)
 - Taking and recording vital signs
 - Grooming and hygiene
 - Bedmaking
 - Turning or moving patient
 - Feeding patient
- Observe changes in patient condition
- Arranging medical appointments
- Provide emotional and physical support
- Provide companionship
