CSSD is a service unit of the hospital/facility responsible for providing guaranteed sterile equipment and instruments for immediate use in patient care.

The course outline focuses on theories and supervised practical training in a simulation laboratory that will provide hands-on learning experience for the students. Our simulation laboratory is equipped to mimic the CSSD set up to fully immerse student in clinical experience. The course will prepare the students with the roles and responsibilities as a CSSD Technician.
